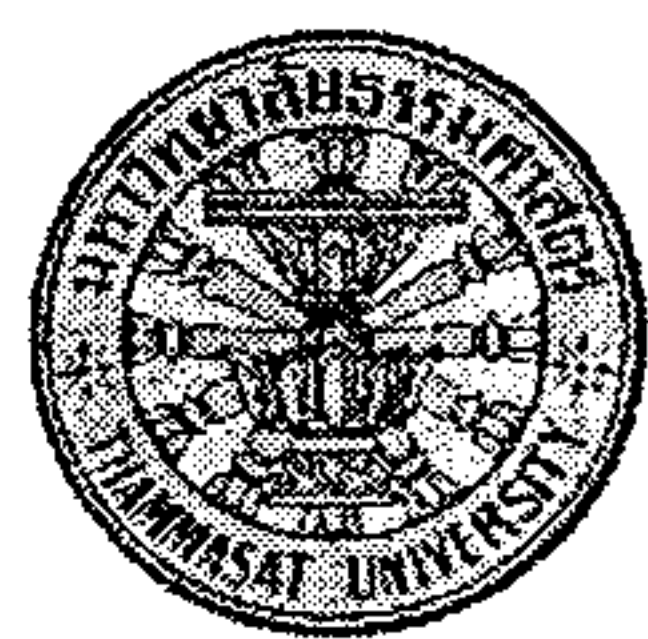

## **New voices in Global Health: The 1<sup>st</sup> International Conference on New Research in Global Health 2013**

### **Background and Rationale**

Global Health addresses the complex roots of problems of global significance like climate change; transitions in demography and epidemiology; health, food and nutrition security; the rise of powerful non-state actors; global economic turmoil-with increasing inequity and global instability; and so on. These problems require solutions that lie beyond the abilities of individual actors, individual sectors, and even sovereign states. Students of Global Health (at Thammasat University and elsewhere) have explored many of these concepts in their studies and examined them in their research. In many ways, today's global health student is challenging more traditional concepts of public health and looking for new approaches and strategies to solve these problems.

### **Objective**

The purpose of the *New Voices in Global Health* conference is to provide a forum where new approaches and new ideas can be heard, considered and debated. In addition, it is intended to offer students an opportunity to circulate their work to a wider audience, either in interested journals, or in the Proceedings of the Conference

### **Topic Areas for Abstracts**

Abstracts for this conference will be considered for acceptance based on their demonstration of the **effect of global forces** on one or more of the following topics of interest:

- ENVIRONMENTAL and Occupational Health
- NUTRITION and Food security



- MATENAL and child health and development
- REPRODUCTIVE and Population Health
- MENTAL Health and Substance Use
- HIV/AIDS
- EMERGENT Communicable and Non-communicable diseases
- VIOLENCE against women and children
- HEALTH System and Human Resources for Health
- OTHER problems that impact on global health

In addition, those abstracts that consider the impact of cross-cutting issues such as human rights, gender, culture and social determinants, human and social capital, global economies and trade, or international law will be given special consideration.

### **Faculty Review Panel**

Submitted papers will be reviewed by a panel of voluntary senior faculty taken from various disciplines of Thammasat and other Universities who will decide on which papers will be invited for oral presentation and poster presentation. Selection through this panel will qualify as peer review.

### **Selection Criteria**

Papers will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Global relevance: the paper addresses a problem that affects populations throughout the world.
- Global impact: the problem has significant impact on global health or development or a clearly related aspect of the same.
- Quality of research: the research methodology is appropriate for the research question, reflects a high level of quality and is implemented correctly, results are clearly stated, and conclusions are clearly separated from results.
- Quality of presentation: the paper or poster is clearly presented (in English) and easily accessible to a general, multidisciplinary audience.
- Originality: the research is original and innovative, offering a new perspective or approach to the problem.
- Relationship to Global Health: while papers do not have to specifically address global health, they should make clear how the results could have an impact – direct or indirect – on global health.

*Note: criteria are the same for acceptance of either oral or poster presentations. Division into those categories will be determined by the presenter's ability to attend the conference without financial support from the conference organizers.*

### **Abstract Submission**

The conference will consist of an invited keynote lecture, oral presentations and poster displays, and a panel discussion by international reviewers. All posters and presentations, as well as additional submissions considered to be of sufficient quality but not presented, will be published as abstracts.

### **Abstract Submission Deadline**

Abstracts should be approximately 500 words, and should include the Title and Rationale/Background, with a summary of Methods, Results and Conclusions. Please indicate if you would be prepared to present the paper in person or as a poster. Travel to the conference will be at the author's expense.

### **Prizes**

Donations from private and public sector bodies will be solicited to award prizes in various categories for the best oral presentation and the best poster presentation determined by the review panel on selected topics.

### **Publication**

Efforts will be made to interest local journals in publishing works of substantive quality. In addition, all posters and presentations, as well as additional submissions considered to be of sufficient quality but not presented, will be published as abstracts in the Proceedings of the conference.

### **Activities**

The conference programs consist of the keynote speaker, oral presentations and poster presentations. The concurrent trade for global health and development exhibition provides the opportunities to the participants to learn and update the new trends of global health from both public and private sectors. A series of oral and poster presentations on the topics related to the global health and development will be presented.

### **Main Activities**

#### **➤ Keynote speaker**

The Rector of Thammasat University will be invited as keynote speaker approximately 15 minutes.



➤ *Oral presentation*

In morning, plenary session: Oral presentations on General Global Health Topics Presentations consist of 10 speakers with 15 minutes of presentation per speaker in Room no. 252.

In afternoon, Specialty Groups: Oral presentations on Special Global Health Topics consist of 30 speakers in 3 breakout rooms (Rooms no. 234, 235, 236), 10 presenters each room with 15 minutes per presentation.

➤ *Poster presentation*

Poster presentations will be available from 10.30-11.00 and 12.00-13.00.
